As a Teaching Assistant, your tasks and activities will be to:

- Work with small groups or individuals to teach English or to support the learning in class
- facilitate small group intervention and support sessions under the guidance of the Student Support Coordinator
- help teachers to evaluate children's development and keep records in collaboration with the class teacher / Student Support Coordinator
- Take a role in playtime and PE supervision
- perform other duties that are necessary in the day-to-day life inside and outside the classroom

You need to have:

- a European (or equivalent) Teaching qualification, already recognised by the Dutch Government (a DUO recognition, please find more information [here](#))
- a valid work permit for The Netherlands
- a commitment to the school's vision and mission to provide community based international learning
- experience of teaching in English (for teachers)
- experience with students who are non-native speakers of English and for whom English is often the second or third language
- excellent knowledge and experience of different teaching and educational methodologies
- an understanding and knowledge of different cultural backgrounds
- excellent communication skills and ability to function well within a team
